Background on FLVC FCS and SUS Resources



- Both collections have been stable over time, with little switching out of content.
- FCS and SUS have fairly different collections, with an emphasis on full-text databases for FCS, and more abstract and indexing databases for SUS
- For FY 2012-2013 legislative allocation for FCS and SUS was combined, but the timeline did not allow for transitioning collections and most resources were renewed intact for each system.

Differences in Current Licensing Activities



- **Group Licensing Process for FCS**
 - FLVC surveys colleges for product interest outside of the core resources; FLVC gets pricing
 - Colleges pay one FLVC invoice; FLVC pays vendors
 - Rapidly growing service, as college 4-year degree programs grow and more products transition to online
 - For 2013, 24 colleges participated, with a total of 117 products from 28 vendors, with a \$1.1 million spend

License Process for SUS



- The FLVC/SUS e-resource collection has been very stable, with little change from year to year
- Periodic in-depth review and analysis of the collection has confirmed its value to the SUS (ERS Prioritization Report)
- For the SUS, FLVC handles centrally funded resources, and large STEM databases and e-journal package negotiation/contract management.
 - Web of Science
 - SciFinder Scholar

E-Journal Deals



- E-Journal “Big Deals” Licensing Process for SUS
 - Includes participants from SUS, FCS and institutions within the Independent Colleges and Universities of Florida (ICUF)
 - SAGE and Springer available to FCS through FLVC
 - Rapid growth of participation by ICUF in 2013
 - ICUF pays FLVC a cost-recovery fee for contract negotiation and management services

Renewal/Approval Process for FLVC/SUS funded resources



CPC's Electronic Resources Subcommittee (ERS) makes recommendations to CPC



Collection Planning Committee (CPC) makes recommendations to Council of State University Libraries (CSUL)



CSUL approves, FLVC renews.

Task Force Charge



- Recommend which E-Resources will be licensed for all college and university libraries.
- Correlate available dollars with the ability to maintain subscriptions, and prioritize if funds will be insufficient to maintain current subscriptions.
- Recommend more permanent committees and task forces necessary to analyze and build joint FCS/SUS library collections.
- Coordinate with relevant FLVC staff and other committees and report to the Executive Committee

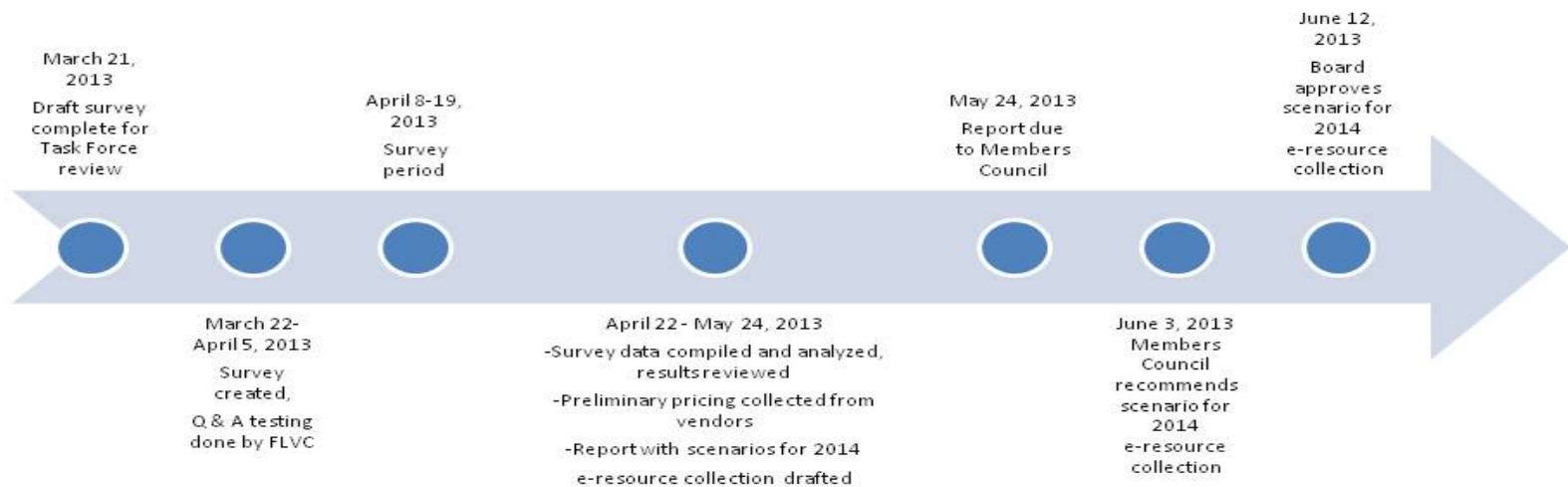


Board makes final decision; FLVC renews.

Timeline for Identifying Core SUS/FCS Resources for 2014



The Plan for Identifying 2014 Collection



- Survey all FCS and SUS libraries for their assessment of core resources and gather information about current subscription spend
- Evaluate survey data to prioritize resources and evaluate financial information provided
- Report to Members Council to include various scenarios for licensing e-resources for 2014.
Scenarios may include:
 - Licensing of a single set of resources for both FCS and SUS
 - Additional scenarios for phasing in a centralized collection
 - Explanations of the impact, cost, benefit and timeline

The Survey



- Distributed through Members Council to be completed by appropriate staff
- Includes e-resources that are:
 - Currently licensed by FLVC for SUS and FCS
 - Currently licensed by FCS and/or SUS libraries individually at a high rate
 - The next generation of existing products (e.g. EBSCO's Source databases, which build upon H.W. Wilson content)

The Survey, cont'd



- Options for rating resources are:
 - High Priority – a core resources for patrons
 - Medium Priority – a useful resource for patrons
 - Low Priority – a minor resource for patrons
 - Not interested
 - Product not known

The Survey, cont'd



- Gathers data to help gauge impact on institutional budgets as FLVC collections change
 - Request information from each institution on what they individually subscribe to and how much it costs
 - Asks for the subscription term
- Ends with questions about interest in large e-journal packages and e-book collections.

Looking Ahead



- Implement recommendations from Members Council for 2014
- Offer group licensing to SUS beginning 2014
- Offer additional opportunities for e-journal package participation for ICUF and FCS in 2014
